What's inside your kit:

- Safety glasses
- 6 sheets of foam core board
- Scissors
- Foam core starter template
- X-ACTO knife with 2 blade replacements
- 8" x 6" self healing cutting mat
- Steel ruler with cork backing
- Hot glue dispenser
- 1 pack of hot glue sticks
- Hot glue dispenser holder kit
- Sketchbook and engineering paper package
- Weaving kit
- 3D-printed lighting kit
- Laser-cut furniture kit

Hardware and Software Requirements:

- Any computer (PC, Mac, or Chromebook) that can run Google Meets (with webcam, mic)
 - iPads are not compatible
- A mouse is recommended for 3D design

Safety Information

- This product contains small and sharp parts. Do not swallow or scratch to avoid injury
- This product contains conductive parts. Do not hold them or touch the power supply and other parts of the circuit

- Use the parts in the kit in accordance with each lesson. If you do not know how to use or wire a part, learn how to use it before connecting it to any source of power.
- Store the kit and all parts in a dry place away from direct sunlight
- Unplug and turn off all power when not in use

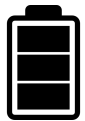
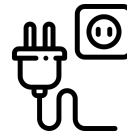
